



1. Create a template by printing the pieces on plain white cardstock, cut them out and use them to trace onto the back side of the cardstock you are going to use. The template used as is will create a left shoe; however, you may create either a left shoe or a right shoe. Just remember if you flip the sole, you must also flip the straps, as the shorter strap will always go toward the arch side of the foot and the longer strap will go toward the outside of the foot.
2. Trace and cut out the pieces. You will need to cut two soles. Flip the second one and do not cut slits in it, as it will be glued to the under-side of the sole to hide the glued tabs.
3. Using a craft knife, cut the three slits in the sole labeled A, B and C.
4. Score the straps on the dotted lines labeled A, B and C.
5. With the straps facing each other (the shorter one on the left for a right shoe, or the shorter one on the right for a left shoe), insert the A tabs into the A slit on the sole. Spread the tabs apart on the under- side of sole and glue in place.
6. Insert tab B into the B slit on the sole and secure it on the under-side of the sole with glue. You will need to slightly twist the bottom of the strap in order for it to properly fit in the slit.
7. Insert tab C into the C slit on the sole and secure it on the under-side of the sole with glue. You will need to slightly twist the bottom of this strap as well.

8. Glue the second (flipped) sole to the under-side of the main sole. This will hide all of the glued tabs.

9. Now you're ready to embellish your flip flop! Have fun!
