## SLIMLINE STEP CARD



These instructions are for creating a $3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ slimline size step card which fits perfectly in a \#10 business envelope.

Cut the card base at 9" x 7-1/2".

## Cut:

On the 9 " side, go $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ in from the edge of the cardstock and cut downward from 1-1/4" to 5". Flip the cardstock over (from left to right) and repeat.

Score:
On the $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side, with the $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ margin on the left, score at 1-1/4", $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $5^{\prime \prime}$ ONLY between the edge and first horizontal cut line. Flip the cardstock upward (from bottom to top) and repeat.
On the $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side, score once again at $3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ONLY between the cut lines.
Fold:
The first, third and center score lines are mountain folds, and the second score line is a valley fold. Burnish all the score line folds with a bone folder.

Layering panel measurements:
$6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ large front rectangle - patterned paper
$6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ large back rectangle - white for sentiment/signature
$8-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{\prime \prime}$ front horizontal bottom strip - patterned paper
$2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{\prime \prime}$ two front side vertical strips - patterned paper
Decorate as desired.
