

ENVELOPE MINI ALBUM

You can use any size envelopes and any number of envelopes. The number of envelopes used will obviously dictate the number of pages in your mini album. You can use pre-made envelopes or you can make your own envelopes with a WRMK Envelope Punch Board.

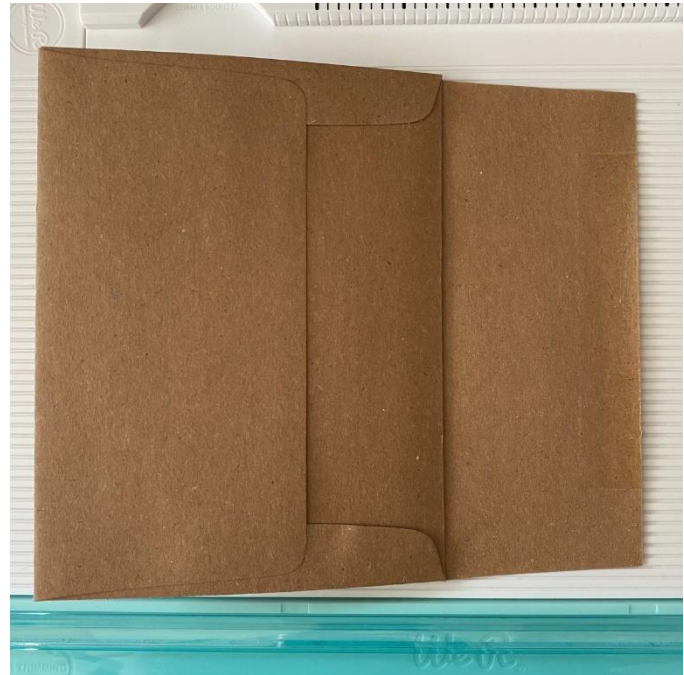
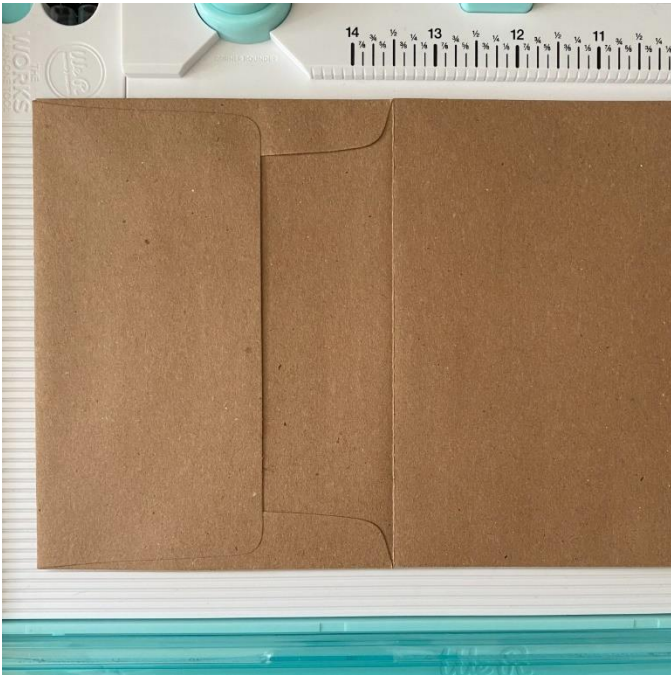
Gather the envelopes you want to use and open all the flaps. Six pre-made envelopes were used here.



Lay one envelope down in front of you on the left with the flap open toward the right. Flip all the remaining envelopes over in a stack on the right with the flaps toward the left and the gummed sides down.



Slide the flap of the first envelope in the right-hand stack into the opening of the envelope on the left. Then fold that envelope over to the left side.



Slide the flap of the second envelope in the right-hand stack into the opening of the top envelope on the left. Then fold that envelope over to the left side. Repeat the process for all the envelopes remaining in the right-hand stack.



With all the envelope pages now on the left-hand side, you'll only have the flap of the original envelope remaining on the right side. That flap will hold the mini album together. Lay the envelopes on your score board and determine the thickness of all the pages. Score down the entire length of the flap, fold the flap over toward the left, and adhere it (on the gummed section) to the last envelope in the stack. This will be the back of the album.



Flip the album over and make sure the edges of all the pages are even. Starting at the front, open each page and slide a little bit of wet glue into the opening to hold everything in place. Do this for each page.



Your album is now complete and ready to be embellished. The patterned paper or cardstock you choose for each page will hide the openings on the left-hand pages where the flaps were inserted. Have fun – the sky is the limit!
